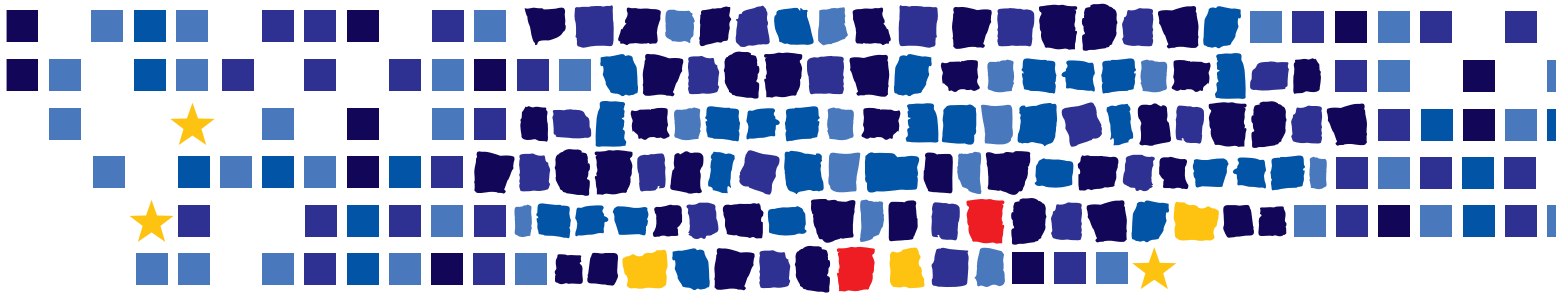


A second seminar was held on 12 December 2022 in Sliema, Malta, during which some recommendations have already been shared.

**Final conference of JuWiLi — Justice Without Litigation project — 9 November 2022, Brussels**

On 9 November 2022, the CNUE hosted the closing conference of the [Justice Without Litigation — JuWiLi project](#), co-financed by the European Commission.

The conference was an opportunity to present the conclusions and recommendations of the project in which the CNUE partnered with the Chambers of Notaries of Austria, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Slovakia and Slovenia, the Universities of Vienna and Graz and the Economic Research Institute Economica.

The project analysed for Austria, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Hungary and Slovakia the term “jurisdiction” in the context of the EU Succession Regulation in non-contentious judicial proceedings by notaries from a comparative law, fundamental rights and rule of law

perspective. The project also included Slovenia where the reflection of policy makers, academics and the Chamber of Notaries on the transfer of judicial tasks to notaries is progressing. The videos of the conference are available [online](#).
